In our day-to-day lives, we can do small actions that can make a big difference for the environment and for our wallets. For example, when choosing lighting for our homes, did you know that LED bulbs can be a great saving over conventional bulbs? They **consume** less electricity, so having them on for the same length of time means less spending at the end of the month. By doing so, we can save almost \$220 a year while contributing to energy savings.

Furthermore, for short trips, bicycles are a better **option** than cars. Aside from saving money on gas, bicycles are a zero-emission vehicle while car fuel consumption increases as you drive, emitting up to 1.7 kilograms of carbon dioxide every 10 kilometres.

Moreover, in the kitchen, we can also reduce costs. A simple action like covering the pot while cooking saves 25%, or even 50% of the gas used, **especially** when using a pressure cooker.

Did you know that one litre of oil pollutes 1000 litres of water? So recycling used oil prevents severe **environmental** damage. And the recycled oil can be used to make soap, fertiliser or fuel.

Last but not least, when shopping, we can contribute to sustainability. Always look at clothing labels and buy fair trade products which guarantee respect for biodiversity and the workers who have made the garments.
