



mount everest


Location

Plans to preserve


- Limit the number of climbers each year.



NÚI BÀ RÁ


Mount Ba Ra (Binh Phuoc) is a majestic historical and natural landmark, rising to 736m. It is renowned for its lush green landscape, rich ecosystem, and heroic historical significance during the resistance against the French and Americans, along with the mythical legend of the "sacred mountain" of the S'tieng people. Visitors are drawn to the area by its 1,767 steps and cable car system, offering a unique experience of exploring nature, spirituality, and history.

BÙ LẠCH

Bu Lach Grassland, located in Dong Nai commune, Bu Dang district, Binh Phuoc province, is a complex of 20 natural grasslands covering nearly 500 hectares, a stunning, pristine area surrounded by primeval forest and clear blue lakes. It's an ideal camping and picnic spot with its picturesque scenery and mild climate year-round.

BÙ GIA MẬP

Bu Gia Map is a border district in the northeastern part of Binh Phuoc province, famous for Bu Gia Map National Park – the "green lung" transitioning from the Central Highlands to the Southeast region. It boasts majestic landscapes, diverse ecosystems, a cool climate, and unique S'tieng culture, attracting ecotourism.

— AMAZONE RAINFOREST —

1 Location

- The Amazon Rainforest is located in South America.
- It covers about 5.5 million square kilometers (2.1 million square miles).
- It stretches across Brazil, Peru, Colombia, Venezuela, Ecuador, Bolivia, Guyana, Suriname, and French Guiana.




2 Special Features / Attractions

- The Amazon is home to about 10% of all known species on Earth.
- There are around 400 billion trees belonging to more than 16,000 species.
- It is home to thousands of animals, including jaguars, macaws, sloths, and pink river dolphins.
- Over 400 Indigenous groups live in the Amazon region.



3 Threats to Its Existence

- Deforestation caused by logging, agriculture, and cattle ranching.
- Climate change leads to droughts and changes in rainfall patterns.
- Illegal mining pollutes rivers with mercury.
- Forest fires destroy large areas of wildlife habitat.



4 Ways / Plans to Preserve It

- Create and expand protected areas and national parks.
- Promote sustainable farming and logging practices.
- Fight against illegal logging and mining activities.
- Support Indigenous communities and protect their land rights.
- Raise global awareness about the importance of the Amazon.


The Amazon Rainforest is often called the "Lungs of the Earth" because of its important role in producing oxygen and absorbing carbon dioxide.

- Sustainable farming methods




- Largest tropical rain forest

MOUNT FUJI



1 LOCATION


Mount Fuji is located in Japan, on the island of HONSHU about 100 km southwest of Tokyo.

It is the highest mountain in Japan, with a height of 3,776 meters.



2 SPECIAL FEATURES/ATTRACTION

- Mount Fuji is a famous active volcano with a nearly perfect cone shape.
- It is covered with snow on the top and surrounded by cherry blossoms.
- The mountain is a symbol of Japan and attracts millions of visitors every year.



3 THREATS TO ITS EXISTENCE

- Climate change causes the snow on Mount Fuji to melt faster.
- Environmental pollution from tourism affects the natural beauty of the area.
- Too many visitors can damage the landscape and ecosystem.



4 WAY/PLANS TO PRESERVE IT

- Limit the number of tourists during peak seasons.
- Encourage visitors to protect the environment and not litter.
- Raise awareness about climate change and nature conservation.
- The government should strengthen environmental protection laws.
